- Directions** The event centre will be at St Marks Church hall, post code RG22 5 LJ & GR SU606498. Exit the M3 at Junction 7, take A30 signs into Basingstoke. Then at Kempshott roundabout, take 1st left into Heather Way and turn almost immediately right into Jasmine Rd; at the sharp left bend the road becomes Homesteads Rd. The Church is around 100m on the right. The parking area at the church premises is limited, but should be sufficient for our needs.
- Map/Areas:** 1:5,000 on A3 waterproof paper, 5m contours. Map created in 2018 for SEOUL, including wide expanses of housing estate and some parkland areas.
- Courses:** 1 hour normal score event, as per guidelines. Controls with various point scores. Control Descriptions will be printed on map and will be available separately at Registration.  
N.B. All juniors under 16 must be accompanied by an adult.  
Punching start (within 100m.), just turn up, register & go!  
EMIT eCards will be used on all courses. Everyone must report to Download afterwards!!
- Times:** Registration: - 17:45 to 18:30 – this will take place in the Hall.  
Starts: - 18:00 to 18:45ish  
Courses close: - promptly at 20:00 please. We must vacate by 2030hrs....
