Directions The event centre will be at the Royal Oak Pub, Charlton, Andover, SP10 4AJ & GR SU351468.

Exit the A303 at the A343/A342 Junction (Ring Road Andover), follow the Ring Road towards Andover Town Centre, at the second roundabout take the first exit (Hurstbourne Tarrant) onto Goch Way, at the next roundabout take the first exit (Charlton) still on Goch Way. At the end of Goch Way you will see the Royal Oak directly in front of you, the car park entrance is on the right-hand side. More parking available 50m south by Tesco Express (road signposted Memorial Hospital) or 100m south at the Charlton Lakeside car park. Please do not park on nearby roads.

Map/Areas: 1:5,000 on A3 waterproof paper, 5m contours. Map totally updated in December 2019, area

comprises Charlton Lakes, Industrial Estates and housing estates.

Courses: 1 hour score event, as per guidelines. Details of the score event format to follow. Control

Descriptions will be printed on map and will be available separately at Registration.

N.B. All juniors under 16 <u>must</u> be accompanied by an adult. Punching start (within 100m,), just turn up, register & go!
