


## UPDATED AREA FOR THE WESSEX NIGHT LEAGUE

- Directions** The event centre will be in the Car Park of Emedia, Shortwood Copse Lane, RG23 7NL, What3Words? sues.warned.highly. Exit the M3 at junction 7 and take the A30 towards Basingstoke, turn right at the 3<sup>rd</sup> set of lights (by the Holly Blue Pub) into Beggarwood Lane. after 350m turn right into Shortwood Copse Lane and then first left into the Car Park. **If you book food at the Holly Blue please park your car there to relieve pressure on the main car park.**
- Map/Areas:** 1:5,000 on A3 waterproof paper, 5m contours. Map updated and extended in Summer 2020, area comprises Beggarwood Park and surrounding housing estates.
- Courses:** 1 hour score event, as per guidelines. Straightforward 30 controls. Control Descriptions are only available as a [download](#).  
N.B. All juniors under 16 must be accompanied by an adult.  
Punching start (400m from Car Park), just turn up for your allocated slot time, collect eTag & go!  
Touch free EMIT will be used on all courses. Everyone must report to Download (at Registration van) afterwards!!
- Covid** When signing up for the event you were asked to confirm your acceptance to following COVID rules. We ask that you bring your own antiseptic wipes or hand wash. It is advised to wear face masks if you chose to engage in conversation with people outside of your immediate family/bubble.
- Times:** Registration: - 17:30 to 19:00 – this will be a van sited in the EMedia Car Park. Pick up your eTag from the van and download there as well.  
Starts: - 17:45 to 19:15. Adequately spaced queue is mandatory.  
Courses close: - promptly at 20:20 please.
- Entry:** Pre-Entry is now full. (please email [urban@bado.org.uk](mailto:urban@bado.org.uk) for enquiries only)

Lost Cards will be charged at £45.
- Facilities:** Toilets will **not** be available at assembly, but there is a Sainsbury's supermarket not far away in Hatch Warren, Limited First Aid only. We will not be able to offer usual Refreshments, so please bring your own. The brand new Hall & Woodhouse pub, Holly Blue is also only 200m away, however please observe the Covid rules.
- Safety:** All competitors **must** wear hi-viz tops & have **sufficient** lights to complete their course (take a back up!). No road crossings will be manned so please take care. Adherence to Covid restrictions is paramount, we will be under scrutiny. Any additional details will be available on the night.
