- Directions** The event centre will be in at the Horse & Groom, 2 Broad Street, Alresford, SO24 9AQ, What3Words? Showcases.durations.centally. Alresford is 8 miles east of Winchester. There is plenty of Parking at Arlebury Park (free after 5pm get a ticket if arriving before 6pm) or the Station (free after 6pm, 30p for one hour) there is free parking on the streets near the pub but is often busy.
- Map/Areas:** 1:5,000 on A3 waterproof paper, 5m contours. Map created in 2020, area comprises the town centre, housing estates and park land.
- Courses:** 1 hour score event, as per guidelines. Straightforward 30 controls. Loose Control Descriptions will be available.
N.B. All juniors under 16 must be accompanied by an adult due to the busy roads.
Punching start just turn up, collect eTag & go!
Touch free EMIT will be used on all courses. Everyone must report to Download afterwards!!
