NEW AREA FOR THE WESSEX NIGHT LEAGUE

- Directions** The event centre will be in at the Whitchurch Parish Hall, 28 London Street, Whitchurch, RG28 7LQ, What3Words? gratuity.conceals.trophy. Whitchurch is 13 miles north of Winchester, next to the A34. Free parking at Bell Street Parking (on the road towards St Mary Bourne) What3Words? cracking.immunity.cured. If full (unlikely), proceed further along Bell Street (about 50m) where the controlled parking ends to find street parking.
- Map/Areas:** 1:5,000 on A3 waterproof paper, 5m contours. New Map created in 2020, extensively updated in 2022; area comprises the town centre, housing estates, park land, small wooded areas and rough open. Area has plenty of climb in northern half, plus if route choice involves the steep disused DN&SR railway line embankments.
- Courses:** 1 hour score event, as per guidelines. Straightforward 30 controls. Loose Control Descriptions will be available at registration.
N.B. All juniors under 16 must be accompanied by an adult due to the busy roads.
Punching start just turn up, collect eTag & go!
Touch free EMIT will be used on all courses. Everyone must report to Download afterwards!!

- Facilities:** Toilets, Teas and Coffees. The Blue Rickshaw Chinese takeaway and fish and chip shop is over the road from the hall. The White Hart is about 150m up the road (passed coming from the car parking). The Hot Spice Indian takeaway is about 100m away.
- Footwear:** Wear shoes that have some grip as the off road areas can be quite slippery and if you tackle the railway embankment you will definitely need significant grip!
- Safety:** All competitors **must** wear hi-viz tops & have **sufficient** lights to complete their course (take a backup!). No road crossings will be manned so please take care. Adherence to current COVID restrictions is paramount. Any additional risk assessment details will be available on the night.
